



65+ SPANISH HOTEL PHRASES

From Helping You Learn Spanish

This is a collection of Spanish phrases based on my years of experience traveling through Mexico and Latin America. You'll find a number of useful Spanish phrases for real world situations that are often not found in traditional Spanish phrasebooks.

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Booking a room

1. **Quiero hacer una reservación.** I want to make a reservation.
2. **¿Es posible cancelar mi reservación?** Is it possible to cancel my reservation?
3. **¿Es posible cambiar mi reservación?** Is it possible to change my reservation?
4. **Quiero cambiar mi reservación.** I want to change my reservation.
5. **Quiero cancelar mi reservación.** I want to cancel my reservation.
6. **Tengo una reservación a nombre de [your name].** I have a reservation under the name of [your name].
7. **¿Cuánto cuesta la habitación por noche?** How much is the room per night?
8. **Quiero una habitación libre de humo.** I want a non-smoking room.
9. **Quiero una habitación para fumadores.** I want a smoking room.
10. **¿Hay habitaciones disponibles?** Are there any rooms available?
11. **¿Puedo ver la habitación?** Can I see the room?
12. **Quiero una habitación sencilla.** I want a single room.
13. **Quiero una habitación doble.** I want a room with double beds.
14. **Quiero una habitación con cama King.** I want a room with a king bed.
15. **¿Hay una habitación más económica?** Do you have a less expensive room?

Check-in

16. **¿A qué hora es la entrada?** What time is check-in?
17. **Vengo a hacer check-in.** I'm checking in.
 - *Surprisingly, Hacer check-in is the industry standard term in the hotel industry (hoteleria).*
18. **Vengo a registrarme.** I'm here to check-in.
 - *If you prefer not to use Spanglish or you're speaking with a staff member that doesn't understand hacer check-in, use this instead.*

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19. **Mi reservación está a nombre de [your name].** My reservation is under the name [your name]
20. **¿Podría ocupar la habitación temprano?** Could I check-in early?
 - *This is a way of asking if you can occupy (ocupar) the room prior to the official check-in time.*

Check-out

21. **¿Cuál es la hora de salida?** What time is check-out?
22. **¿A qué hora tengo que hacer check-out?** What time do I have to check-out?
 - *Like hacer-check-in, hacer check-out is the standard term in the hotel industry.*
23. **¿A qué hora tengo que entregar la habitación?** What time do I have to check-out?
 - *If you prefer not to use Spanglish or you're speaking with a staff member who doesn't understand hacer check-out, use this instead.*
24. **¿Podría entregar la habitación un poquito más tarde?** Could I check-out a little later?

Asking about the room

25. **¿La habitación tiene microondas?** Does the room have a microwave?
26. **¿La habitación tiene teléfono?** Does the room have a phone?
27. **¿La habitación tiene caja fuerte?** Does the room have a safe?
28. **¿La habitación tiene aire acondicionado?** Does the room have air conditioning?
29. **¿La habitación tiene calefacción?** Does the room have heat?

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Asking about hotel amenities

30. **¿A qué hora es el desayuno?** What time is breakfast?
31. **¿El hotel tiene WI-FI?** Does the hotel have WI-FI?
32. **¿Ofrecen traslados al aeropuerto?** Do you offer transportation to the airport?
33. **¿Hay servicio de cuarto?** Is there room service?
34. **¿El hotel tiene piscina?** Does the hotel have a pool?
 - *In México it's also common to hear the term alberca instead of piscina.*
35. **¿El hotel tiene restaurante?** Does the hotel have a restaurant?
36. **¿El hotel tiene bar?** Does the hotel have a bar?
37. **¿El hotel tiene servicio de tintorería?** Does the hotel have a dry-cleaning service?
38. **¿El hotel tiene servicio de lavandería?** Does the hotel have a laundry service?
39. **¿A qué hora abre el gimnasio?** What time does the gym open?
40. **¿A qué hora abre la piscina?** What time does the pool open?
41. **¿Cuál es el horario del gimnasio?** What are the gym hours?
42. **¿Cuál es el horario de la piscina?** What are the swimming pool hours?
43. **¿El desayuno está incluido?** Is breakfast included?

Navigating the hotel

44. **¿En qué piso está mi habitación?** What floor is my room on?
45. **¿En qué piso está el gimnasio?** What floor is the gym on?
46. **¿En qué piso está el restaurante?** What floor is the restaurant on?
47. **¿En qué piso está la piscina?** What floor is the pool on?
48. **¿Dónde están los ascensores?** Where are the elevators?

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In the room – Asking for things

49. **¿Podría enviarme una plancha y tabla de planchar?** Can you send me an iron and ironing board?
- *You can also use traer or mandar instead of enviar.*
50. **¿Podría enviarme unas toallas?** Could you send me an iron and ironing board?
51. **¿Podría enviarme una cobija?** Could you send me a blanket?
52. **¿Me trae unas toallas?** Can you bring me some towels?
53. **¿Me da unas toallas extra?** Can you give me some extra towels?
54. **Sólo necesito toallas.** I just need towels.

Quick tip: Use traer (to bring) if you're speaking directly to the person who will bring you what you need. For example, when you're speaking to the maid. Use dar (to give) if it's something that will be immediately handed to you.

Use enviar or mandar (both mean to send) if you're speaking with the front desk or a staff member who will have the item(s) sent to your room.

In the room – Common situations

55. **The toilet won't flush.** El inodoro no baja.
56. **No hay agua caliente.** There's no hot water.
57. **No hay agua.** There's no water.
58. **Se me perdió la llave de mi habitación.** I lost my room key.
59. **Se me quedó la llave dentro de la habitación.** I left my key in the room.
60. **¿Cómo hago una llamada local?** How do I make a local call?
61. **¿Las llamadas locales son gratis?** Are local calls free?
62. **¿Cuál es la contraseña del Wi-Fi?** What's the Wi-Fi password?

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Storing your luggage

63. **¿Podría guardarme el equipaje después de entregar la habitación?** Could you hold my luggage after I check out?
64. **¿Hay un lugar dónde pueda guardar mi equipaje en el hotel?** Is there a place to store my luggage in the hotel?
65. **¿Hay un lugar dónde podamos dejar nuestro equipaje hasta la hora de registrarnos?** Is there someplace we can leave our luggage until check-in?

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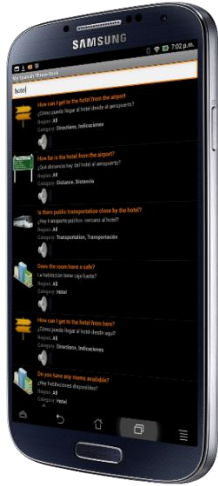
